Recipe

Vegan Deviled Potatoes

12 small red, yellow, or white potatoes

6 Tbls vegan mayonnaise

1 tsp Dijon mustard

1/2 tsp apple cider vinegar

1/2 tsp black salt (I used fine sea salt)

1/4 tsp turmeric

Paprika or smoked paprika for garnish

Directions: Boil potatoes for 12-20 minutes until the potatoes are tender and you can easily pierce them in the center w/knife (time varies depending on the size of potato). Drain potatoes and rinse with cool water.

When the potatoes are cool enough to handle, cut each potato in half length-wise. Use a scoop to scoop out potato flesh in a bowl and mash with a fork.

Take the potato flesh and add vegan mayo, Dijon mustard, apple cider vinegar, salt, and turmeric, mix well. Then if using a pastry bag use a tip large enough that you can pipe into potato well or spoon in, garnish with the paprika. Serve right away or cover and store in fridge until ready to serve.

Try to find potatoes that are about the size of an egg, the pre-bagged ones are too small. Black pepper.
